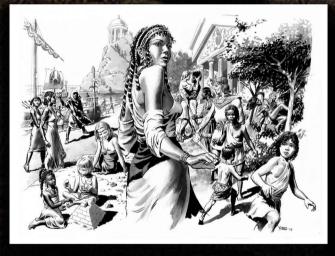


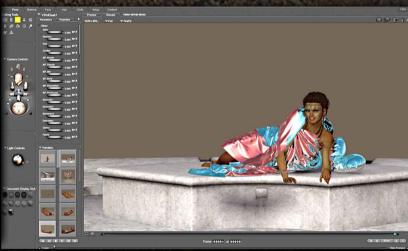

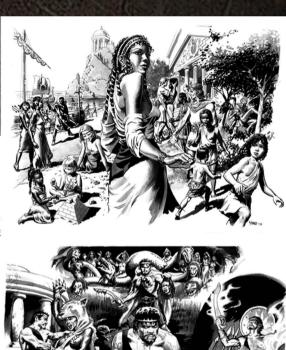

Cursed for the murder of his brother, God Set languishes in misery until his wife, Nephthys comes to redeem him. The story happens in the realm of the Gods and men; and, as she does so, the death of Osiris is retold as a love story between cult Osiris and cult Isis.

In concert with this Egyptian theme, another theme rears its ugly head; the impact African sexual practices had on the ancient world.

Discreetly addressed in Sacred Blood is an ugly truth, one I believe James Baldwin sums up best:

"The price one pays for pursuing any profession or calling is an intimate knowledge of its ugly side."

The ugly side of this tale has to do with the abuse of women and children.

The conflict between the native Greek population and white Doric Greeks immigrating into the area reached its peak when white tribes refused to accept children born of the Orgia – a baptismal rite within the Passion of Osiris - as legitimate.

This refusal created what we know today as Bastards.

In addition, these white clans initiated a reign of terror where men, women and children were subject to rape if discovered and captured at night by Satyrs.

Over time this cruel treatment produced a large abused population that finally betrayed its native heritage and set about destroying Bronze civilization.

The story is untold and deserves exposure.

What adults don't know is that game designers place cheat codes inside games, which allow children to cheat to win.

In Gaming without Cheats, students discover they can win using skills, tactics and strategy. Students learn that their decisions have risks, benefits, costs, outcomes and rewards depending on the quality of their decision making; and that good decision making creates good citizens.





Afterschool Programs



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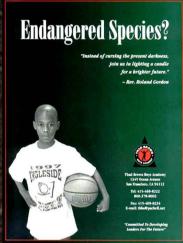
- -Students don't have to learn programming before they can apply critical thinking in designing their own game scenarios.

Do Black Lives Matter?

What we are experiencing in America is a massive erosion of self-esteem, across the board. Globalization has left America adrift and in crisis, with an economy that demeans large sectors of Americans. Nowhere is this more prevalent than the African-American community.

Do black lives matter? It's a question few dare to ask in our current social climate; but it's one that needs attention from not only whites, but blacks as well. Given the carnage occurring each day within the black community due to black on black crime, the question deserves serious attention – not just slogans painted on walls or protests in the streets. The question that confronts the black community is a painful one. Why are African Americans, predominately black males, choosing to commit suicide by police? This is an exceedingly tough question the black community wants to side-step and avoid.

A quote from James Baldwin is appropriate here," Not everything that is faced can be changed, but nothing can be changed until it is faced." The African American community must come to grips with self-hatred and the sacrifice of human life that it entails upon the altar of self-esteem. The black community needs to re-imagine itself; and to accomplish this objective, new skill and perspectives are necessary.



The learning system Sacred Blood is designed to promote the skill necessary for re-imagining social change from an alternative perspective in the black community. The system is based on Visual Thinking Strategies and Positive Psychology as a means of raising self-esteem by becoming "makers" – people who create, invent and learn. In this age of disinformation, it uses art to encourage critical thinking and communication skills; and visual literacy to promote group problem solving.

By re-imagining black youth as makers the system hopes to support positive events and influences in their lives; thereby, raising their self-esteem through experiences of joy, satisfaction, contentment, happiness, optimism and flow. But more importantly, the objective is to strengthen character and virtue – the primary one being, temperance, since black youth are sadly in need of forgiveness, mercy, humility, prudence and self-control.
